BrightHive Data Sharing Workshop

A common challenge across government digital transformation is the ability to get the right data, to the right people, at the right time to drive impact. Thinking beyond data sharing as a transaction, this session will highlight public-private data sharing successes in States like CO and CA, using a collaborative format to engage people working towards adoption of multi-party data sharing agreements on behalf of their own agencies. BrightHive will share success stories from supporting state and city governments in signing multi-party data sharing agreements called "data trusts," and best practices in establishing, staffing, and executing associated data governance bodies. This session will begin with a presentation, but will focus on workshopping how to design collaborative approaches between program staff, IT and legal teams, to build trust and buy-in while addressing the specific needs and challenges at different organizations. After presenting



basic strategies, the facilitator will source participants for specific challenges and obstacles, then work collaboratively in groups to develop appropriate responses. Attendees will take home copies of executed data sharing agreements from a variety of government agencies.
